

Pure Momentum Consulting Terms of Use

These Terms of Use (these “Terms”), together with the Privacy Policy¹ of Pure Momentum Consulting, LLC (“Pure Momentum Consulting”, “we” or “us”), set forth the terms and conditions that apply to your access and use of the Pure Momentum Consulting website located at <https://www.puremomentumconsulting.com> (the “Site”). Pure Momentum Consulting’s respective officers, directors, employees, consultants and agents are referred to herein as “Related Parties”. Pure Momentum Consulting’s services may include, but are not limited to, management consulting services that support executives and boards at small and mi-sized non-profits. (the “Services”).

By using or accessing our the Site you agree to these Terms, as updated from time to time in accordance with Section 9 below. These Terms state that any disputes between you and Pure Momentum Consulting must be resolved in arbitration or small claims court.

1. Account Security. To use the Site you must (a) not have been previously suspended or removed from the Services; and (b) register for and use the Site in compliance with any and all applicable laws and regulations.

2. Account Registration. To access some features of our Site, you may be required to register for an account. When you register for an account, we may ask you to give us certain identifying information about yourself, including but not limited to your email address and other contact information, and to create a user name and password (“Registration Information”). When registering for and maintaining an account, you agree to provide true, accurate, current, and complete information about yourself. You also agree not to impersonate anyone, misrepresent any affiliation with anyone else, use false information, or otherwise conceal your identity from Pure Momentum Consulting for any purpose. You are solely responsible for maintaining the confidentiality and security of your password and other Registration Information. For your protection and the protection of other users, we ask you not to share your Registration Information with anyone else. If you do share this information with anyone, we will consider their activities to have been authorized by you. If you have reason to believe that your account is no longer secure, you must immediately notify us at lydia@puremomentumconsulting.com.²

3. Specific Requirements for Certain Services. Your use of the Services constitutes your acknowledgment and acceptance of the following specific requirements and terms of use for certain of the Services.

4. Prohibited Conduct. You agree not to:

a. Use the Site for any illegal purpose, or in violation of any local, state, national, or international law;

- b. Violate or encourage others to violate the rights of third parties, including intellectual property rights;
- c. Post, upload, or distribute any content that is unlawful, defamatory, libelous, inaccurate, or that a reasonable person could deem to be objectionable, profane, indecent, pornographic, harassing, threatening, hateful, or otherwise inappropriate;
- d. Interfere in any way with security-related features of the Site;
- e. Interfere with the operation or any user's enjoyment of the Site, including by uploading or otherwise disseminating viruses, adware, spyware, worms, or other malicious code, making unsolicited offers or advertisements to other users, or attempting to collect personal information about users or third parties without their consent;
- f. Access, monitor or copy any content or information of the Site using any robot, spider, scraper, or other automated means or any manual process for any purpose without Pure Momentum Consulting's express written permission;
- g. Perform any fraudulent activity, including impersonating any person or entity, claiming false affiliations, accessing the accounts of other users without permission, or falsifying your identity or any information about you, including age or date of birth; or
- h. Sell or otherwise transfer the access granted herein.

5. Third Party Content. The Site may contain links to third party websites and services. Pure Momentum Consulting provides such links as a convenience, and does not control or endorse these websites and services. You acknowledge and agree that Pure Momentum Consulting has not reviewed the content, advertising, products, services, or other materials that appear on such third party websites or services, and is not responsible for the legality, accuracy, or appropriateness of any such content, and shall not be responsible or liable, directly or indirectly, for any damage or loss caused or alleged to be caused by or in connection with the use of any such third party websites or services.

6. Intellectual Property. You acknowledge and agree that you relinquish all ownership rights in any ideas or suggestions that you submit to Pure Momentum Consulting through the Site. This Site is protected by applicable copyright and other intellectual property laws, and no materials from the Site may be copied, reproduced, republished, uploaded, posted, transmitted, or distributed in any way without our express permission. All trademarks and service marks on the Site belong to Pure Momentum Consulting, except third-party trademarks or service marks, which are the property of their respective owners.

7. Indemnification. You agree that you will be personally responsible for your use of the Site, and you agree, to the fullest extent permitted by applicable law, to defend, indemnify, and hold harmless Pure Momentum Consulting and our Related Parties from and against any and all claims, liabilities, damages, losses, and expenses (including attorneys' and accounting fees and costs), arising out of or in any way connected with (a) your access to, use of, or alleged use of our the Site; (b) your violation of these Terms or any applicable law or regulation; (c) your violation of any third party right, including without limitation any intellectual property right,

publicity, confidentiality, property, or privacy right; or (d) any disputes or issues between you and any third party. Pure Momentum Consulting reserves the right, at our own expense, to assume the exclusive defense and control of any matter otherwise subject to indemnification by you, and in such case, you agree to cooperate with our defense of such claim.

8. Termination. If you violate these Terms, your permission to use the Site will automatically terminate. In addition, Pure Momentum Consulting, in its sole discretion may suspend or terminate your user account and/or suspend or terminate some or all of your access to the Services at any time, with or without notice to you. You may terminate your account at any time by contacting Pure Momentum Consulting at lydia@puremomentumconsulting.com. After your account is terminated, information and content previously provided by you will no longer be accessible through your account, but Pure Momentum Consulting may continue to store such information and content, and it may also be stored by third parties to whom it has been transferred through your use of the Site.

9. Modification of these Terms. Pure Momentum Consulting reserves the right at any time to modify these Terms and to impose new or additional terms or conditions on your use of the Site. Such modifications and additional terms and conditions will be effective immediately upon notice and incorporated into these Terms. We will make reasonable efforts to notify you of any material changes to these Terms, including, but not limited to, by posting a notice to our website or by sending an email to any address you may have provided to us. Your continued use of the Services following notice will be deemed acceptance of any modifications to these Terms.

10. Disclaimers of Warranties. This Site is provided “as is” and on an “as available” basis, without warranty or condition of any kind, either express or implied. Although Pure Momentum Consulting seeks to maintain safe, secure, accurate, and well-functioning services, we cannot guarantee the continuous operation of or access to our Site, and there may at times be inadvertent technical or factual errors or inaccuracies. Pure Momentum Consulting specifically (but without limitation) disclaims (a) any implied warranties of merchantability, fitness for a particular purpose, quiet enjoyment, or non-infringement; and (b) any warranties arising out of course-of-dealing, usage, or trade. You assume all risk for any/all damages that may result from your use of or access to the Site. Pure Momentum Consulting does not guarantee the accuracy of, and disclaims all liability for, any errors or other inaccuracies in the information, content, recommendations, and materials made available through the Site.

11. Limitation of Liability. To the fullest extent permitted by applicable law, neither Pure Momentum Consulting nor its Related Parties shall be be liable to you for any incidental, special, consequential, direct, indirect, or punitive damages, whether based on warranty, contract, tort (including negligence), statute, or any other legal theory, whether or not Pure Momentum Consulting or its Related Parties have been informed of the possibility of such damage. 12. Governing Law. These Terms are governed by the laws of the State of California, without regard to conflict of law principles. Subject to [Section 13](#), which provides that disputes are to be resolved through binding arbitration or small claims court, to the extent

that any lawsuit or court proceeding is permitted hereunder, you and Pure Momentum Consulting agree to submit to the exclusive personal jurisdiction of the state courts and federal courts located within San Francisco County, California, for the purpose of litigating all such disputes.

13. Dispute Resolution by Binding Arbitration. In the interest of resolving disputes between you and Pure Momentum Consulting in the most expedient and cost effective manner, you and Pure Momentum Consulting agree to resolve disputes through binding arbitration or small claims court instead of in courts of general jurisdiction. Arbitration is more informal than a lawsuit in court. Arbitration uses a neutral arbitrator instead of a judge or jury, allows for more limited discovery than in court, and is subject to very limited review by courts. Arbitrators can award the same damages and relief that a court can award. Any arbitration under these Terms will take place on an individual basis; class arbitrations and class actions are not permitted. You acknowledge and agree that the arbitrator may award relief (including monetary, injunctive, and declaratory relief) only in favor of the individual party seeking relief and only to the extent necessary to provide relief necessitated by that individual party's claim(s). Any relief awarded cannot affect other users.

14. Modification of the Site. Pure Momentum Consulting reserves the right to modify or discontinue, temporarily or permanently, some or all of the Site at any time without any notice or further obligation to you. You agree neither Pure Momentum Consulting nor its Related Parties will be liable to you or to any third party for any modification, suspension, or discontinuance of any of the Site.

15. General.

a. Entire Agreement. These Terms, together with the Privacy Policy, constitute the entire and exclusive understanding and agreement between you and Pure Momentum Consulting regarding your use of and access to the Site, and except as expressly permitted above may only be amended by a written agreement signed by authorized representatives of the parties.

b. No Waiver. The failure to require performance of any provision shall not affect our right to require performance at any time thereafter, nor shall a waiver of any breach or default of these Terms constitute a waiver of any subsequent breach or default or a waiver of the provision itself.

c. Paragraph Headers. Use of paragraph headers in these Terms is for convenience only and shall not have any impact on the interpretation of particular provisions.

d. Severability. In the event that any part of these Terms is held to be invalid or unenforceable, the unenforceable part shall be given effect to the greatest extent possible and the remaining parts will remain in full force and effect.

16. Notice to California Residents.
